Hereinafter individually referred to by name or Party and collectively as Parties as the case may be.

WHEREAS:

- A. The Company operates a Hotel known as **W KUALA LUMPUR, Malaysia** (hereinafter called "the Hotel")
- B. The Learning Institution has expressed interest for its students ("the Participants") to participate in the practical training program (hereinafter called "Industrial Trainee Program") to be conducted by the company at the Hotel.
- C. The parties have agreed that Participants shall undergo the Training Program in accordance with the terms and conditions hereinafter provided.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:-

1. The School shall provide certificate Students who have successfully passed the interview for Placement carried out by the Employer for Placement in the Hotel.
2. The period of the Placement for the Students is Six (6) months and shall commence on 15 JUNE 2019 or such other date as may be agreed in writing by both parties ("Placement Period").
3. During the Placement Period, the Students will be placed in one (1) department only i.e Food & Beverage Departments to be able to have the real-life exposure in the hotel industry.
4. The Placement of each Student is subject to approval of the professional visit passes of the Students by the Malaysian authorities.

SCHOOL'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- 5.1 In respect of each Student, the School will provide the following:-
 - i. certified copies of academic certificates, passport and two (2) passport size photographs of the selected Students;
 - ii. One original copy of the Student's curriculum vitae;
 - iii. One original or certified true copy of the current medical report of each Student.
- 5.2 The School shall also provide air passage for the Students from India, to Kuala Lumpur International Airport, Malaysia and from Kuala Lumpur International Airport, Malaysia to India upon successful completion of the placement period of each student.
- 5.3 The school or its appointed agent shall arrange and bear the cost of professional visit pass for each Student at the Malaysian Immigration Department.
- 5.4 The School shall be responsible for repatriating any Student who has violated the Hotel's rules and regulations or the laws of Malaysia and further the School shall bear all cost resulting there from.
- 5.5 The School shall review the progress and performance of each Student with the Hotel's management staff approximately three (3) months from the commencement of the Placement.
- 5.6 The School shall be responsible for ensuring the Students are well informed prior to the commencement of the Placement of the following:-

- a. The Students are to carry out all duties assigned to them at the Hotel and must work under the supervision of the Hotel's personnel.
 - b. The Students shall be courteous and polite to the Hotel guests, staff and supervisors at all times.
 - c. Students must conduct themselves in a proper and well-behaved manner and to abide by the following rules at all times:
 - i. to strictly adhere to punctuality and attendance and when on duty be neatly attired in the uniform provided and shall be clean and neatly groomed;
 - ii. during working hours and when on the Hotel premises, the Students are required to abide strictly to the Hotel's rules and regulations (which may be amended at any time and from time to time), the company policies and the instructions from the Hotel General Manager or his representatives;
 - iii. to refrain from engaging in any vicious or immoral activities;
 - iv. to refrain from entertaining or to be entertained socially by the guest of the Hotel.
 - d. The Students are not allowed to work in Malaysia after they have completed their Placement.
 - e. The Students shall not divulge any valuable, confidential and proprietary information of the Hotel which may have come into their knowledge or possession during the course of their Placement.
- 5.8 The School shall be responsible of informing the Students prior to the commencement of the Placement of the following work schedule:-
- The trainees may be required to work for 48 hours per week, inclusive of forty five (45) minutes break per day, but the following conditions must be observed:
 - Not to exceed 48 hours in one week
 - The rest day is to be determined by the Hotel at its absolute discretion;
- 5.9 The School is responsible for informing the Students prior to the commencement of the Placement that the Employer bears no responsibility as an employer while they are performing their Placement.
- 5.10 The School shall ensure that the Students have the necessary consents or permission required (if any) prior to the commencement of the Placement.
- 5.11 The School shall take and maintain sufficient and adequate insurance coverage for the Students with reputable insurance companies covering the risks, inter alia of accidents and injury whilst at work or outside work premise and all inpatient (hospitalisation) and if so requested shall submit copies of the aforesaid insurance policies to the Employer and shall keep the Employer notified in the event of cancellation or modification and renewal of the said insurance policies.

- 5.12 If any of the Students shall behave in a manner which in the sole and absolute opinion of the Employer is unbecoming or may jeopardize the reputation or image of the Hotel or cause damage to any part of the Hotel or if the Student fails to comply with the rules and regulations of the Hotel or and the company policies of the Employer, the Employer shall forthwith terminate the Placement of the Student without notice and the School shall be responsible for repatriating the Student back to Nepal as set out in Clause 5.5 above.

EMPLOYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

6.1 During the period of the Placement the Employer shall provide:-

- i. practical/ hands-on experience for the Students ;
- ii. Duty Meals at the Hotel's staff cafeteria;
- iii. Outpatient medical consultation at the Employer's panel of clinics up to a maximum of RM80.00 per person per month any excess will borne by the student;
- iv. Accommodation for the Students on a sharing basis will provide by Wide Global Management Consultancy (WGMC).
- v. the outbound transport from accommodation to airport charges shall be borne by Wide Global Management Consultancy (WGMC).

6.2 The Employer agrees to pay RM400.00 (Ringgit Malaysia Four Hundred) only per month as practical work allowance for each Student and RM 10.00 (Ringgit Malaysia Ten) only per hour as over time allowance for each Student.

6.3 All Students who have successfully completed the Placement will be issued a Certificate of Completion of the Placement from the Hotel.

6.4 The Employer shall as soon as practicable inform the School of any accident or untoward incident involving the student.

6.5 While the Hotel staff may supervise the Students during the Placement, the School retains responsibility for all learning outcome and the accuracy of any Student assessment arising out of the Placement.

COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

7.1 This MOU shall commence on the date of its signing and shall remain in effect for a period of one (1) year subject to review upon expiry, at which both parties shall by mutual agreement determine the terms and conditions of any extensions or duration of this MOU.

7.2 Either party has the right to terminate this MOU or the Placement by giving one (1) month prior written notice to the other.

7.3 Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MOU shall be settled amicably by consultation between both parties in good faith.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY

- 8.1 The School acknowledges that the Employer and the Hotel shall not be liable at any time for any accidents, injuries and/ or deaths (collectively as "accidents") that may fall for any reason whatsoever on the Students during the Placement. The School undertakes to indemnify the Employer in full in the event any claim is made against the Employer or the Hotel by the Student in respect of the aforesaid accidents.
- 8.2 The School shall be fully liable to the Employer in event the Employer suffers any loss or damages as a result of the Student's negligence, omission or breach of any of the terms of the Placement or MOU and the School shall fully indemnify the Employer for such loss, costs or damages suffered thereby.

OTHERS

- 9.1 All Notices arising from this MOU shall deemed to have been delivered:
- a. in the case of hand delivery, upon written acknowledgement of receipt by an officer or other duly authorized employee, agent or representative of the receiving Party;
 - b. in the case of registered mail, seven (7) days upon dispatch or upon acknowledge receipt by the receiving Party, whichever earlier;
 - c. in the case of facsimile, upon successful completion of the transmission.
